

Open your web browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer) and type www.flickr.com into the address toolbar.




To sign in in future, the home page will look slightly different.

Open your web browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer) and type www.flickr.com into the address toolbar. Click on Sign In – as highlighted in the picture.



Use your Yahoo address and email to sign in.



Once you have uploaded photos the welcome page will look more like this. In the top left hand side of the black bar it will say "You" instead of "Sign Up", your name and user name will appear and your display picture will be on both the left and right hand side, as shown.
